Application Eligibility & Submission Requirements

Eligibility Criteria

- Graduating High School Senior (Class of 2019)
- Must be graduating from a high school located within San Diego County
- Minimum unweighted grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. If you are awarded the \$1000 scholarship, we may verify your GPA from your transcript; if we cannot verify your GPA, you may forfeit your scholarship.
- Accepted to an accredited, four (4) year college or university. Scholarships can only be awarded to accredited schools within the U.S.

Selection Considerations

- Academic Record
- Extra-Curricular Activities
- Employment / Internships
- Community Service / Volunteer Service
- Quality of written statements and essays

Application Packet Elements

Completed Scholarship Application Form. The application is designed to collect academic and personal background information for the scholarship review committee. Responses to the application questions will be a decisive factor in the selection process. All questions and essays must be answered thoroughly and truthfully. Incomplete application forms /packets will NOT be considered.

Essay. The application contains an essay section. There are multiple essay topic questions, but only one is required for the application. The essay must:

- Contain 500-1000 words.
- Be typed, using either Courier New or Times New Roman font with a font size of 12.
- Use single spaced lines.

Proof of College Acceptance/Application. A letter of acceptance or proof the scholarship applicant has applied to a college or university must be mailed with the scholarship application. In order to receive payment of the scholarship awarded, recipients must show proof of academic enrollment at an accredited, four (4) year college or university for the 2019 fall semester.

Transcripts. Transcript of grades must be submitted with the scholarship application.

Scholarship Application Deadline. Scholarship application **MUST** be postmarked by 8 April 2019. Materials postmarked after this deadline will NOT be considered.
